Covid has affected everyone's life in Scotland.

In 2021 Scotland's First Minister Nicola Sturgeon announced that the Scottish Government would fund a programme of **co-created** community **memorial** projects in every council area in the country.

**Co-created** means different people and organisations working together.

A **memorial** is an object or structure that is made to remind people of a person or event.



greenspace scotland is the organisation delivering this project.

The project is called Remembering Together.



Remembering Together will **commission** artists and creative workers to work with communities.

**Commission** means to arrange for something to be produced.

Remembering Together will:

- create places to connect with other people and to remember what has happened
- find ways to remember people who died from Covid
- find ways to respect people who experienced loss and change
- celebrate the ways that Scottish communities come together at difficult times.



Remembering Together is a space where we can share what has happened, and what is still happening.

The work will continue through 2022 and into 2023.
